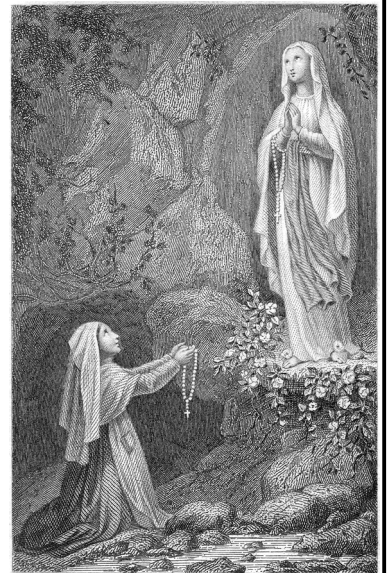

R. JAMBON WILL BE LEADING a special devotional exercise to Our Lady of Fatima this coming Friday, October 13, beginning at 6 PM. There will be the recitation of the Holy Rosary, followed by a special talk, and then an outdoor candlelight procession with a beautiful statue of Our Lady of Fatima leading the way. Please consider attending this grace-filled event. **An opportunity for all Catholics to gain a plenary indulgence during the 100th Anniversary of the Fatima apparitions has been announced.** For the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal, Pope Francis has decided to grant a plenary indulgence opportunity throughout the entire anniversary year, which began Nov. 27, 2016, and will end Nov. 26, 2017. The Holy Father has detailed three specific ways for Catholics to obtain this indulgence:

**1. Make a pilgrimage to the shrine:** The first way is for "the faithful to make a pilgrimage to the Fatima Shrine in Portugal and participate in a celebration or prayer dedicated to the Virgin."

**2. Pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima:** The second way applies to "the pious faithful who visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory or proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to

October (2017), and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary." This prayer can be done in any location in the world, not just in Fatima or Portugal.

**3. The elderly and infirm:** The third way to obtain a plenary indulgence applies to people who, because of age, illness or other serious cause, are unable to visit any solemn exposition of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima as detailed in the second method above. These individuals can pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and must spiritually unite themselves to the jubilee celebrations on the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month, between May and October 2017.

**Conditions for obtaining any plenary indulgence**

As usual and above these 'good works' the usual conditions apply for who wants to gain the plenary indulgence: As usual and above these 'good works' the usual conditions apply for who wants to gain the plenary indulgence: (i) State of grace when performing the indulgenced act; (ii) Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; (iii) Confession within 8 days before or after the indulgenced act; (iv) Holy Communion within 8 days before or after the indulgenced act; (v) Prayers for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (Our Father & Creed). **THE MIRACLE OF THE SUN & POPE PIUS XII**

Cardinal Tedeschi revealed how Pope Pius XII experienced the Miracle of the Sun: "'*Signum Dei!* We have seen the sign of God!' Such was the reflection which the stupefied crowd made on October 13, 1917. Mary, 'clothed with the sun' had, so to speak, shaken the edge of Her heavenly mantle for just a few instants. The sun obeyed Her orders, and in obeying Her had imprinted on the messages of Fatima a more striking seal than any emperor ever could have made. Everything here is extraordinary, everything worthy of the Queen of Heaven! It is a marvel never seen before! ... another person saw this miracle. He saw it outside of Fatima. He saw it many years later. He saw it at Rome. And this person is the Pope, Pope Pius XII himself! This took place at four o'clock in the afternoon on Oct 30 and 31, and on November 1 of 1950: and once more at the same hour on the octave day of November 1... Was this grace a reward for him? Was it a sign showing that the definition of the dogma of the Assumption [made Nov 1, 1950] had been supremely pleasing to God? Was it a heavenly testimony, intended to authenticate the connection of the mystery of Fatima with the Head of Truth and the Catholic Magisterium? It was all three things at the same time." ✠

Mr. Douglas Hyde, former director of the *Daily Worker*, the journal for English speaking communists, converted after reading and pondering upon a book about the apparitions at Fatima. This book was sent to him so that he could refute it. Mr. Hyde wrote: "One day I received a copy of a book entitled *Our Lady of Fatima* by Msgr. Ryan. A note accompanied it, drawing my attention to pages 90 and 92, where it dealt with Russia and communism, and asked me to refute them. I brought the book to my house and placed it in my library among the works of Marx, Lenin, Stalin and other Marxist writers. I have now been a Catholic over three years and this book, with the sender's note which I fastened to it, is one of the most precious treasures. I have it here at Lisbon, and I would be happy to show it... For me, the message of Our Lady of Fatima is the only foundation for a hope that soon communism which divides this world will be overcome, and Russia will be converted. Without this hope there is no hope, since in less than thirty years, communism has come to dominate a third of humanity, and its progress continues... Only this certainty that prayer and penance are the way of salvation saves from despair those who know the nature, strength and diabolical character of communism, because communism is diabolical and perhaps the worst thing the world has ever known." ✠
